

## Argus Oracle Consent Form

Students registered in RAQA/GCPR courses using Argus Oracle must complete and sign this form before they will be given a User Number/Password to access the system. The signed form must be returned to the RAQA Office.

By signing this form, students acknowledge that they agree to the following:

- User Numbers and Passwords are required to access the Argus Oracle system. Only students currently enrolled in the RAQA or GCPR course identified below will be assigned a User Number/ Password.
- Each User Number/Password is unique and may be used only by the student registered in the RAQA/GCPR course specified below.
- The User Number/Password may not be used, shared, or given to any other individual, including, another Temple RAQA/GCPR student; a work colleague; a friend or acquaintance; a family member, or on any form of social media.
- The Argus Oracle system will be used only for assignments associated with the course listed below on this form.
- The User Number/Password will only be valid for the term of a course. At the end of each semester, all User Names and Passwords are automatically cancelled.
- The student agrees to keep the password in a secure place. If a password is lost or misplaced, there will be a \$25.00 charge to retrieve or replace the password the first time. The second and subsequent times, the charge to replace a password is \$50.00. Passwords can only be retrieved by contacting David Brickett (267.468.8566 or [dbrick@temple.edu](mailto:dbrick@temple.edu)) during normal working hours.
- Routine surveillance of User Numbers/Passwords will be conducted during the semester. If suspicious activity is discovered, a forensic audit trail will ensure.
