Located in Philadelphia, the School of Pharmacy is among the healthcare and pharmaceutical industry hubs of the northeastern United States. Our home on the Temple University Health Sciences Center campus is a nucleus of healthcare education, research, and delivery.

- 1. Temple University School of Pharmacy was **established in 1901**, making it one of the **oldest pharmacy schools in the country**.
- 2. **0-6 Early Assurance Program**—students can complete the PharmD program in as little as six years directly out of high school.
- 3. 83.4% on-time graduation rate for the Class of 2024.
- **4. \$2.5** million in scholarships were awarded to students in 2024–2025.
- 5. 83.2% of graduating students were **offered a job or postgraduate training position prior to graduation** in 2025.
- 6. Accredited by the **Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE)**, ensuring a high-quality education that meets the national standards for pharmacy practice.
- 7. **Student-to-faculty ratio is 10:1** and faculty are specialists, researchers, and experts in their field.

- 9. Students get hands-on experience in the lab and at clinical sites starting in year one by leveraging interprofessional opportunities with Lewis Katz School of Medicine, Maurice Kornberg School of Dentistry, and Temple University Hospital on the Temple University Health Sciences campus.
- 10. Boost your resume with a dual degree: including an MBA, MS in Global Clinical and Pharmacovigilance Regulations, an MPH, or a graduate certificate in Drug Delivery, Drug Discovery, Pharmacokinetics, or Pharmacogenomics.
- 11. Customize your path with a concentration in Clinical Trials, Drug Safety, Advanced Clinical Practice, or Community Practice.
- 12. Tuition for 2025-2026: \$41,230 (in state), \$44,230 (out of state).


